- Manage Care for Real's annual donor thank-a-thon and assist with other donor and funder stewardship efforts.
- Craft custom acknowledgement letters and regularly update general acknowledgement communications in partnership with the Development Associate.

- Assist Development team with grant writing, reports, research, meeting preparation, presentations, website updates, donor profile management, gift processing, and collateral material development as needed.
- Serve as the point person for designing, writing, printing, and posting on-site signage and all internal communications collateral materials.
- Co-develop and manage the annual Development & Communications Plan with the Director of Development & Communications
- Contribute to social media content by capturing photos, videos, and quotes.
- Lead donor tours, attend community events, and connect with prospective donors as needed.
- Partner with Program & Partnerships Manager to identify potential partners and sponsors.
- Support Executive Director and Development Director with donor meeting preparation.
- Help with client-facing programs as needed.
